

## COLORADO COUNTY AREA GO-TEXAN 2022 SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

**IMPORTANT INFORMATION** for 2022 Colorado County Area Go-Texan Scholarship:

**9 - \$3,500 Scholarships will be awarded for a student pursuing a four-year degree.** Three – to Columbus graduating seniors, three - Rice Consolidated graduating seniors, and three - Weimar graduating seniors.

**9 - \$2,500 Scholarships will be awarded for a student going to a technical or trade school for a certification program.** Three – to Columbus graduating seniors, three – Rice Consolidated graduating seniors, and three – Weimar graduating seniors.

**Applicants are required to be a member of 4-H or FFA while enrolled in high school.** The scholarship from Area Go-Texan is open to every eligible senior enrolled in a public high school who meets the criteria.

**Deadline** for all scholarship applications and documentation must be postmarked by **April 1st, 2022**. All applications and documentation should be mailed to:

### **Additional information for scholarship recipients:**

- You are **required** to attend all Colorado County Area Go-Texan events.
  - Next event is our Scholarship Fundraiser Dinner & Auction schedule for Sept. 2022 and will follow up via email or text message when the date and place is confirmed.
- Students are required to take a minimum of 12 hours.
- Scholarships will not be paid out until after the official drop date. Scholarship payout will be divided between the first and second semester. Student must maintain a 2.5 GPA to receive the second half of the scholarship.
